I'm sure there are a few fans of The Cure on here, so I was wondering what you think so far of the new singles (and b-sides if you've heard them).

Also, I heard a while ago that the new album was going to be a double CD (or at least Robert Smith would himself produce a double CD as well as the record label putting out a single disc version). More recently I heard that this idea seems to have gone and instead they are going to release a single CD album using only the poppy, upbeat tracks. I like all The Cure's stuff, but I tend to prefer the gloomier side of them on albums such as Bloodflowers, Pornography and Disintegration, so I really hope this later rumour isn't true. Anyone have anymore info about the new album?

Anyway, personally I've liked both singles so far. Neither amazing, but pretty good. The latest b-side "All Kinds of Stuff" is very good too, but I'm not so keen on the first b-side "NY Trip". I hope there are going to be stronger tracks on the album, and until I hear for sure that it won't be happening, I'm keeping my fingers crossed for the double CD.

This month: Sleep When I'm Dead (Mix 13) and b-side Down Under.

For the first 20 seconds, Sleep When I'm Dead had me worried. But then it gets a kickstart and becomes a good song. The Only One is definitely the catchiest single so far, but this song is about as good. This single rocks slightly more than the first two, but still keeps that upbeat tone.

As for the b-side, Down Under, it seems The Cure have done it again - putting a better song as the b-side than the single. This is one of those Cure songs where it just seems to have a magical air to it somehow.

The last 2 singles have both had b-sides better than the singles themselves, in my opinion. To be honest, out of the 6 new songs so far I've only not liked one of them - NY Trip. Not that NY Trip is a particularly bad song, just not all that great either.

Although the quality of the songs so far has got me very excited about the new album, it's also made me even more disappointed that it's not going to be a double album. The Cure are the kind of band that could pull off an awesome double album, they have a lot of variety and rarely write bad songs so could probably do a 2 hour album where you don't get bored before the end. Maybe it could even have rivalled MCIS! Oh well :(

So the album's been delayed a month, so now is due on October the 13th :(On the bright side, an EP is coming out on September 13th comprising of 4 remixes of the singles. The next (and last) single is going to be A Perfect Boy, which there's a link to a live version of in this thread. Judging by my memory of the live performance (though I only listened to it once), it could be the best of the singles.

I got all this from Robert Smith's latest blog on MySpace. Possibly the most interesting comment was this:

"AND I NEED A BIT MORE TIME

AND IN WHAT ORDER...

The release date is now the 27th of October in the UK (28th in US). Or at least that's what I'm getting from online retailers, although I haven't heard any official statement from the Cure's website or MySpace saying there has been another delay (as it was supposed to be out on the 13th).

I've listened to the remix EP now. The first 2 tracks (The Only One and Freakshow) are very much dance mixes. The Only One isn't bad, but Freakshow (to my ears) is terrible - could both work well in a dance club I suppose, but that's not really my thing. The next two (Sleep When I'm Dead and Perfect Boy) stick more closely to the original versions, but Perfect Boy falls flat, leaving the Sleep When I'm Dead remix as the only one that I like - and even that isn't as good as the original version.

And then there's the 65 Days of Static remix of all 4 singles. I thought this was going to be something clever where they actually mixed bits of all 4 songs into one long track. It's not. It's a remix of each of the 4 singles which for some reason are compiled together into one track despite them clearly being 4 different songs/mixes. Still, it has it's moments, but at over 20 minutes long I don't find it good enough to justify taking up that much of my time.

And it's here. I got the new Cure album this morning and have given it a few listens today, whilst laying around the house ill. No really, I am, it's just a coincidence that I'm ill the day the new Cure album came out!

This was my most anticipated CD since Zeitgeist... partly because I love The Cure, and partly because it seems like I've been waiting for it for so long. I was originally expecting this about a year ago (it was first rumoured to be coming out near the end of 2007), then the release date was supposed to be spring 2008, then September 13th, then October 13th... so for the last year I've always felt it was just out of reach. Well, finally, it's here - woohoo!

But does it live up to the mammoth expectations I built up for it? To be honest, no. But then it would've had to rival Disintegration and Bloodflowers in order to live up to my hopes. But then, after the album finished the first time, the slight disappointment subsided and I realised that whilst it isn't totally amazing, it is still very good. Like all Cure albums, it definitely stands apart from all their others, though if I had to compare it with their previous work I'd say it stands closest to Wish.

Course, I've only listened to it a few times. Already this year there have been a couple of albums that didn't seem amazing on first listen but got better with each listen (Agony & Irony by Alkaline Trio and All Hope Is Gone by Slipknot). I would already put this in my top 5 albums of this year so far (although to be honest it's been a fairly poor year for new albums coming out, I think) and after several more listens maybe it will climb higher up the list.

I might add a bit more about specific songs after I've listened more and had more time to digest it, then again I might not :)

And Underneath the Stars is gonna be a classic. That song is brilliant, worth the album alone. It could have easily been taken from the disintegration sessions; absolutely amazing.

The rest of the album does seem a bit like a sort of compilation of Cure styles, ala Kiss me; not sure if that was because it was their 30 year album. But now that that obligation is out the way, the next par should be masterful!
